Aesthetic Education: Introductory Course

Course Code: LCI 62000

2 credits

For new Partnership and Focus Schools participants. The requirements are as follows:

- Participate in Summer Session for five days from July 13-17, 2009
- Attend two special one-hour discussions with Dr. Maxine Greene held during lunch.
- Attend a lecture by Dr. Maxine Greene during Summer Session (included in your regular workshop schedule)
- Prepare a paper for Dr. Greene based on a mutually agreed-upon topic. This paper is in addition to the paper required of all new Partnership and Focus School participants

Aesthetic Education: National Educator Introductory Course

Course Code: LCI 62100

2 credits

For introductory level National Educator Workshop participants. The requirements are as follows:

- Participate in Summer Session for five days either during July 6-10 or July 13-17, 2009.
- Attend two special one-hour seminars with Dr. Maxine Greene held during lunch.
- Attend a lecture by Dr. Maxine Greene during Summer Session (included in your regular workshop schedule)
- Prepare a paper for Dr. Greene based on a mutually agreed-upon topic. This paper is in addition to the paper required of all National Educator Workshop participants.

Aesthetic Education: Advanced Course

Course Code: LCI 62200

1-2 credits

For returning participants from Partnership and Focus Schools, Teacher Education Collaborative institutions and returning National Educator Workshop participants. The requirements are as follows:

- Participate in Summer Session for three or five days during the weeks of July 6-10 and July 13-17, 2009.
- For one credit, attend three workshop days, one lecture, and one seminar
- For two credits, attend five workshop days, two lectures, and two seminars
- Prepare a paper for Dr. Greene based on a mutually agreed-upon topic (required length will vary based on number of credits attempted).

SPS Graduate credit fees:

Tuition for the Summer Session courses is \$270.00 per credit (\$540.00 for 2 credits)

Application fee is \$70.00

Please complete a attached SPS application form and submit with a check covering the \$40 application fee and tuition for the number of credits to be awarded by your course and a copy of your official undergraduate transcript before **June 19, 2009**. Under "Prospective Students," click on "registration form" for a PDF copy of the form. Currently matriculated CUNY graduate students should not use the attached form but should instead register through ePermit.

An SPS representative will be at the Summer Session Registration Desk from 8:30 a.m. - 9:30 a.m. on Monday, July 6 and Monday, July 13 to conduct late registrations and to accept official transcripts. Checks should be made payable to the **CUNY School of Professional Studies**.

Participants must be registered in an eligible LCI workshop to request graduate credit. A workshop day is defined as 6 hours (9:30 am to 4:30 pm with a one-hour non-working lunch).
